

# Domestic and Family Violence Services

## Wyn Carr House

Wyn Carr House offers crisis accommodation to women over the age of 18 years, unaccompanied by children. This service is able to accommodate seven women in share facilities. The accommodation is for women who are experiencing a crisis situation due to domestic violence or homelessness, mental health issues, and/or substance use issues.

It has become increasingly apparent that many of the above situations overlap and are complex issues that women who present at Wyn Carr House have to deal with in their daily lives. Wyn Carr House staff apply a case management/support plan approach in assisting/supporting women to work towards their identified needs.

Wyn Carr House is committed to improving the lives of all women, by giving them a safe space, support and information to act upon their identified needs. Wyn Carr House seeks to assist women to recognise and further develop their strengths and abilities in order to achieve and improve quality of life. Wyn Carr House provides support and accommodation for women escaping domestic violence or other crisis situations.



## Indigenous Family Violence

The Indigenous Family Violence Project works to prevent family violence using a community development model. If communities are strong and united the risk of violence occurring is less.

The Indigenous Family Violence Project aims to work with new and established groups to help build the capacity of the group to become strong, self-sufficient and sustainable. We do not do the work for you but work along side you.

The program:

- recognises the complex nature of family and community violence in Aboriginal communities, including the importance of involving and targeting men as well as women and children in the solutions;
- uses models of service delivery and activities that are determined at the community level;
- adopts a holistic approach to the problem and encourages strong links with other relevant service providers in the community.
