



Stacks high for charity day

STAFF from Victoria Park's UnitingCare West will be flipping out today as part of Shrove Tuesday's pancake cook-up.

About 30 local volunteers will congregate on the steps of Perth's Wesley Church, serving pancakes to promote the

message of community.

Spokeswoman Michelle Snowden said funds raised from the sale of pancakes would go towards UnitingCare services.

"Donations and funds raised will help UnitingCare provide practical support

throughout the year to more than 1.8 million people without a home, children and young people at risk, the frail and aged, families in crisis and those with disabilities," Ms Snowden said.

"We will have around 30 volunteers and UnitingCare

West staff helping to cook and serve pancakes, shake mix and do street collecting.

"In 2008, nationally, there were more than 34,000 volunteers that assisted in helping run Pancake Day events.

"We will be expecting around the same this year."
